







MUSIC OF THE NIGHT

Music Of The Night is a student directed, choreographed, and produced Broadway musical revue that is now nine years in the running. Every year, four directors are chosen by the directors of the previous year to fill the next slot. Directors are chosen based upon leadership ability, talent, and their way of working with other people. "MOTN" has become one of the most popular traditions at Santa Barbara High School, causing quite a hype during the high school "teaser" shows, and allows students to fully test their talent and leadership qualities sans adults. The directors run auditions, choose songs, organize rehearsal schedules, choreograph, teach music, and ultimately pull together the entire show based on their own personal knowledge of the theatre. All performers must be extremely dedicated to remain in the show. They often give feedback and opinions that greatly alter the outcome of the final performances (this show is no monarchy, and all feedback is greatly appreciated by students). Ultimately, the directors simply guide the show and get it up and running while the student performers bring the power, talent, and ambition to make it such a success. Rehearsals begin mid-November and continue - picking up speed and intensity - until the show dates. Music Of The Night is a truly unique process in which the "kids" find themselves in charge of every aspect of their show.
